
Chasing rhythm

adhu Mohan, is an electrical design engineer from the nuclear power industry in Canada. Even while operating at such high level of proficiency, he managed to pursue Indian classical music. He is trained in both Carnatic and Hindustani classical music. He left his lucrative job at Canada to learn classical music. He picked up a Diploma, a gold medal in MA music and obtained Ph. D from the Chennai University for his research on Pitch Analysis. Having obtained the doctorate and proficiency in Carnatic music he started performing regularly in Chennai.

Not satisfied with classical music he cut an album in Hindi with light music songs. The album titled *Meri Chahat* was composed and sung by him.
